



FRED WESLEY WENTWORTH - PATERSON'S ARCHITECT DOWNTOWN WALKING TOUR

The downtown Paterson work of the architect Fred Wesley Wentworth will be the focus of a Lecture and Walking Tour on Saturday, **October 27, 2007** at 10 am. The Lecture and Tour will be led by Richard Polton, a professional in urban affairs and Paterson native. Wentworth live in Paterson from 1889 to 1943 and designed many of the commercial and institutional buildings in the downtown. The tour will meet at the **Hamilton Club, 32 Church Street, Paterson, NJ at 10 am** and is scheduled for approximately two and a half hours.
